
## How do I apply?

## How can I answer questions?

★ You can answer the questions however you prefer to:

- You can talk through them
- You can prepare notes before the meeting
- You can make a PowerPoint presentation to show us
- You can record your answers over video before the interview
- You can send over your answers written
- You can draw a picture to explain your answers
- ★ The people interviewing will take some notes.
- ★ You will have a chance to ask any questions too.
- ★ If the team feel like this is a good role for you, they will get in touch to arrange a second interview.
